PROVISIONAL ACCESSION OF THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC

The Fifth Procès-Verbal extending, until 31 December 1970, the Declaration on the Provisional Accession of the United Arab Republic, as approved by the Council of Representatives on 16 December 1969, is open for acceptance at the office of the secretariat. The text of the Procès-Verbal is reproduced below.

FIFTH PROCES-VERBAL EXTENDING THE DECLARATION ON THE PROVISIONAL ACCESSION OF THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC

The parties to the Declaration of 13 November 1962 on the Provisional Accession of the United Arab Republic to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (hereinafter referred to as "the Declaration" and "the General Agreement", respectively),

Acting pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Declaration,

Agree that

1. The period of validity of the Declaration is extended for a further year by changing the date in paragraph 4 to "31 December 1970".
2. This Procès-Verbal shall be deposited with the Director-General to the CONTRACTING PARTIES to the General Agreement. It shall be open for acceptance, by signature or otherwise, by the United Arab Republic and by the participating governments. It shall become effective between the Government of the United Arab Republic and any participating government as soon as it shall have been accepted by the Government of the United Arab Republic and such government.
3. The Director-General shall furnish a certified copy of this Procès-Verbal and a notification of each acceptance thereof to the Government of the United Arab Republic and to each contracting party to the General Agreement.

Done at Geneva this sixteenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine in a single copy in the English and French languages, both texts being authentic.
