## BRAZILIAN SCHEDUEE <br> Request for E Jension of Waiver

The foilowing commicition has iveen received from the Permanent Representative of Brayil in Geneva with the request that this matter be considered at the meeting of the Councill on 12 February.

1. Upon recommendation by the Council on date of 19 May 1969 ( $I / 3205$ ), the CONTRACTING PARTISS, acting pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 5 of Article XXV of the Generaj fgreement and in accordance with the procedures adopted by them on I November 1956, decided to extenc until the end of their twenty-sixth session the time-limit provided for in paragraph 3 of the Decision of 27 February 1967 (BISD, Fifteenth Supplement, page 75), suspending the application of the provisions of Irticle iI of the General Agreement to the extent necessary to enable the Government of Brazil to apply the rates of duty provided in its new Customs Tariff, subject, among other conditions, that the Government of Brazil entered into negotiations or consultations jursuant to Article XXVIII.
2. Notwithstanding the efforts made by Brazjl and the various contracting parties concerned and the substantial progress already reported to the CONTRACTING PARTIES ained at termineting these negotiationsand consultations, it has not yet been possible to concluade them.
B. The Brazilian dejegation is, at present, engaged in active negotiations with ther interested contracting parties, in an effort to finalize them by the end of this month. Howevor, given the short period of tife available it may prove materially impossible to conctude them within the time-limit of the present extension of the Brazilian waiver.
3. Under these :ircumstances, the Brazilian Government submits that a further extension of the wairer will be necessary in order to completc these negotiations. I would therefore appreciate it very much if you would kindly refer the matter to the consideration of the COMTRACTING Paitide.
