Addendum

In response to GATT/AIR/785 the United Kingdom delegation has submitted the following list of import restrictions on items other than cotton textiles applied by France to Hong Kong with 1970 quota levels. These are all unilateral quotas imposed by the French authorities without the agreement of the authorities either of the United Kingdom or of Hong Kong.
