## Notifiea Restrictions or Restraints Imposed or Maintained Fursuant to the Ionz-Tome sranzenent Regaring Intemational Trade in Cotton Textiles

The following is a list of those itoms notifiec to the Joint Working Party on Ipport Restrictions whioh were not discussed in viow of the existence of a speciol forun to deal with tho ootton textile problam. The list comprises only notiried import restrictions and export restraints; hence, adational restrictions ma crist on some or all inports of listod products into the countrios show. These notificetions hare also been delated fron the consolidated to.jle. To the extent that the original notifications included non-cotton items, they remain on: the list of restrictions in innox I.

In general, apart fron ccses where products are further describod in country boxes, the expression "ex" before the BTN number denotes only that non-cotton products cre excludad from consiceration hore; all or substentially all the products in listed Brow sub-hedings sere subject to restriction in so far as they relate to cotton ads immeted from the indicatel somposs. Sor the status of notificatious on on-motory stioles of the same ciasses, see hanex I.

The symbol "XR" should be taken as on axport restraint applied by Japen in all cases. The symbol "Susp(Jip)" denotes suspension of a restriction ageinst Jopen subject to that country operating on export restraint at an agreed level. "DL" followed by a country aboreviation also donotes a restraint applied to the goods of one country only, but "DL" slonc refers to a restriction applicable, in form at least, to ell countries or a group of countries.
