RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM POLAND

Notifications by Contracting Parties

1. Contracting parties were invited in airgram GATT/AIR/812 of 28 July 1970 to notify by 15 September 1970 for the purpose of item (i)(c) of the plan for the annual review of Poland's trade with contracting parties¹, action taken under paragraph 3 of the Protocol for the Accession of Poland² to remove remaining quantitative restrictions on imports from Poland.
2. The Council at its meeting on 28 April 1970 approved guidelines for the form and content of the notifications. These guidelines were reproduced in GATT/AIR/812.

EUROPEAN ECONOMIC COMMUNITY

In connexion with the third annual review under article 5 of the Protocol for the Accession of Poland to GATT, and in response to your request of 28 July 1970, I have the honour to forward herewith lists of products still subject to quantitative restrictions when imported from Poland. These products are designated by full heading number of the Common Customs Tariff of the Community. The lists have been drawn up in accordance with the guidelines approved by the Council on 28 April 1970, and supplement the information furnished previously (document L/3241/Add.3 of 5 November 1969).

The attached lists also indicate the value of imports of products which were still subject to quantitative restrictions. Lastly, the recapitulation table shows a substantial decline in the number of quantitative restrictions still maintained, and also indicates that there has been an increase in the overall value of imports of products still subject to these restrictions.

GREECE

Further to my letter of 12 December 1969 (L/3241/Add.5), I have the honour to forward to you herewith statistics of trade between Greece and Poland during the years 1967, 1968 and 1969; these statistics which are arranged by SITC section have been furnished by the Greek National Statistical Service.

It will be noted that exports under section 2 show a substantial increase in 1969 over the corresponding figures for 1968; this is attributable to a slowing down in cotton export shipments in 1968, and these are, therefore, included in the statistics for 1969.

In view of the fact that these statistics do not entirely tally with the corresponding figures in document L/3399 of 1 June 1970, I am instructed by the appropriate Greek authorities to give the following explanation:

Differences between the Polish and Greek statistics are attributable to the fact that on the Greek side the valuation of products imported from Poland is in terms of the c.i.f. price, and on the other hand to the time lag between consignment of goods and their arrival at the port of destination. Goods are recorded by the Greek statistical services only after arrival.

As regards Greek exports to Poland in 1969, for which the valuation is in terms of the f.o.b. price and which show a substantial increase under section 2, it should be noted that substantial exports of Greek cotton took place in November and December 1969 and these may not have been recorded in the statistics for that year of Poland's imports from Greece.

With reference to GATT/AIR/812 I have the honour to give you the following information regarding the three points mentioned in the said aerogram:

1. The answer to this is to be found in the annex to my letter of 14 June 1968 (see document L/3093, page 45).
2. The new list as per 1 January 1970, is as far as Poland is concerned almost identical with the list already sent you in my letter mentioned above. Some technical adjustments have been made with regard to the tariff numbers of certain textile products. The BTN No. 39.01.009B, Other vessels, etc., has, subject to certain reservations, been taken out of the list.
3. In a separate annex is to be found a statistical survey on the imports from Poland.

As already has been mentioned both in my letters of 14 June 1968 (document L/3093, page 50) and 26 June 1969 (document L/3241) I should like to recall that my Government already for a number of years has pursued on an autonomous basis a liberal policy with regard to imports from Poland.

I have the honour to refer to GATT/AIR/812 of 28 July 1970, and to inform you that South Africa does not apply, and did not apply on 30 June 1967, any discriminatory import restrictions to imports from Poland.

SWEDEN

Since 1 October 1965, when a large number of products imported from Poland were liberalized, only a few products are subject to import restrictions. On 30 June 1967 the quotas mentioned below were applied for Swedish imports from Poland. Certain of these quotas have been increased, last time with effect from 1 January 1970. Most of these quotas have not been fully utilized.

SWITZERLAND

In response to your communication of 28 July (GATT/AIR/812), we have the honour to inform you that the Swiss notification on commercial policy measures applied towards Poland, dated 14 May 1968 (BISD, Sixteenth Supplement, page 78) is still entirely valid.

UNITED KINGDOM

1. A list of products subject to discriminatory import restrictions on 30 June 1967 has already been forwarded to the secretariat and appeared in Annex V to Spec(68)53 of 11 June 1968. The additional information now requested (i.e. the list expressed in customs tariff terms) is not available.
2. A consolidated list of restrictions incorporating the further liberalization measures which were introduced by the United Kingdom with effect from 1 May 1970 is not yet available. The annex to this note is a list of the items which were removed from import restriction with effect from 1 May 1970. A consolidated list of restrictions expressed in tariff terms, together with the list of import quotas also expressed in tariff terms, is expected to be available later this year and when it is, copies will be forwarded to the secretariat.
3. Detailed statistics in respect of all the products subject to import restriction are not available but total imports into the United Kingdom from Poland in 1967-69 of goods subject to discriminatory restrictions were as follows:

I have been instructed to advise you that the United States continues to maintain no discriminatory prohibitions or quantitative restrictions directed toward imports of Polish goods into the United States.
