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IMPORT RESTRICTIONS OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

Addendum

The Permanent Representative of South Africa has submitted the following text of Government Notice No. R.2281 dated 13 December 1974.

The notice sets out in more detail, the relaxation of import control announced by the Minister of Economic Affairs on 4 December 1974 (L/3786/Add.7).

IMPORT CONTROL

I, Owen Pieter Faure Horwood, in my capacity as Minister of Economic Affairs and acting by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Import and Export Control Act, 1963 (Act 45 of 1963), do hereby prescribe the following regarding import permits for 1975.

<u>Paragraph 1.</u> The goods mentioned in this paragraph in column (1) below and provided for in the respective customs tariff items, as shown in column (2), are hereby exempted from the provisions of Government Notice 1918, dated 6 December 1957, and may be imported into the Republic of South Africa, from any country, without an import permit.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. The attention of importers is directed to the fact that this notice becomes operative on the date of publication, but its contents are not applicable to 1974 import permits.

 The expiry date of 1974 import permits is 31 March 1975.

 2. Importers are reminded of the following:
- (i) Goods should not be shipped unless the importer is in possession of an appropriate valid import permit. Goods which arrive at ports in the Republic of South Africa and for which the importer cannot produce a valid import permit will be deemed to have been imported in contravention of the Import Control Regulations.
- (ii) Import permits may not be negotiated, sold or used to the benefit of any firm not named in the import permit. without the prior written approval and consent of the Director of Imports and Exports. Any import permit which appears to have been used in this manner will be cancelled and withdrawn forthwith.
