#### ICELAND - TEMPORARY IMPORT DEPOSIT SCHEME

\* .....

In a letter dated 21 May 1974, the permanent delegation of Iceland has communicated the following for the information of the contracting parties.

1. The Ministry of Commerce, in consultation with the Cential Bank of Iceland, has decided to introduce an import deposit scheme which will be valid from 20 May 1974 to 30 September 1974. The measure is based on provisions of Act No. 30/1960 on import trade and foreign exchange transactions and regulations No. 79/1960 and No. 162/1967.

2. On purchase of exchange for imports or acquisition of import documents against a bill of exchange or a promissory note, the importer shall deposit with his exchange bank (2) per cent of the value of the imports. The import deposit shall be transferred to the Central Bank where it will be blocked for ninety days. Thereafter the deposit will be refunded with an interest rate of 3 per cent per annum.

3. Deposits are payable on imports, although transfers have not been made through an Icelandic exchange bank. The import deposit scheme applies to all imports except the tariff positions listed in the attached annex, which includes the following main categories: cereals and fodder, coffee, sugar, tea, cacao, salt, petroleum products, fishing gear, fertilizers and souds, raw materials for industry, wine, spirits and tobacco, pharmaccutical products, newsprint.

4. Individual deposits of IKr 1,000 and less are exempt from the scheme. Furthermore commodities imported against credit in excess of twelve months are exempt.
