RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM POLAND Notifications by Contracting Parties Addendum

- 1. Ten notifications on restrictions on imports from Poland were circulated in document L/4073 dated 3 September 1974.
- 2. The following notifications have subsequently been received from the Governments of Japan, Malawi and Sweden.

JAPAN

The Government of Japan does not apply any discriminatory restrictions on imports from Poland.

MALAWI

- 1. Malawi imports from Poland were not subject to discriminatory import restriction by 30 June 1967.
- 2. 1 above applies to question 2; also no amendments up to 1 July 1974 have been made the list for 30 June 1967.
- 3. As above.
- 4. There has been no additional progressive relaxation of the discriminatory element in the restrictions as no restrictions were exercised or introduced.
