First Annual Report to CONTRACTING PARTIES

1. In compliance with the Decision of 26 November 1971¹, the countries participating in the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries submit to the CONTRACTING PARTIES information concerning the operation of the Protocol. In adopting the Decision, the CONTRACTING PARTIES considered that trade negotiations among developing countries should have as their objective expanding access on more favourable terms for developing countries in one another's markets through an exchange of tariff and trade concessions directed towards the expansion of their mutual trade. The CONTRACTING PARTIES noted that the establishment of preferences among developing countries could make an important contribution to the expansion of trade among developing countries and to the attainment of the objectives of the General Agreement. They also noted that countries members of the Protocol intended to keep under review the possibility of promoting negotiations for additions or enlargements to the schedules of concessions. The CONTRACTING PARTIES, in adopting the Decision, expressed the hope that all developing countries not participating in the arrangements will consider acceding to the Protocol.

2. The present report has three sections. Section one describes the activities of the Committee of Participating Countries during the period under review. Section two contains some comments on the statistical information provided by participating countries on trading relationships under the Protocol and section three reproduces the tabulations containing the statistical information supplied by participating countries.

I. COMMITTEE OF PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

A. Entry into force and status of ratifications

3. The Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries which was signed by sixteen developing countries entered into effect on 11 February 1973 for the following participating countries: Brazil, India, Israel, Republic of Korea, Pakistan, Spain, Turkey and Yugoslavia. The Protocol has also entered into force for four additional participating countries: Tunisia (7 March 1973), Egypt (15 August 1973), Chile (19 May 1974), Mexico (29 August 1974) and enters into force for Greece on 1 November 1974. Ratification procedures have not yet been completed by Peru, Philippines and Uruguay.

B. Compliance with Decision

4. Participating countries have fully observed the provisions of the Protocol and the terms of the Decision of the CONTRACTING PARTIES of 26 November 1971. No contracting party has requested consultations with participating countries on the grounds that benefits accruing to it under the General Agreement may be or are being impaired unduly as a result of the arrangements set out in the Protocol, nor has any contracting party suggested that these arrangements are being applied inconsistently with the Decision of 26 November 1971. Consequently no such matters have been brought before the CONTRACTING PARTIES as provided for in paragraph (d) of the Decision.

C. Activities of the Committee

5. A Committee of Participating Countries provided for in the Protocol was established for the purpose of giving effect to those provisions of the Protocol involving joint action and, generally, with a view to facilitating the operation and furthering the objectives of the Protocol. During the period under review, the Committee has held sessions in May and September 1973, and in January, April, July and October 1974, under the Chairmanship of Messrs. L.A. Pereira Souto Maior and A. Bier (Brazil) and of Dr. H. Villar (Spain).

6. The Committee of Participating Countries has adopted decisions concerning rules of procedure and a procedure for rectifications of a purely formal character to the schedules of concessions.

7. No changes have been introduced to the schedule of concessions annexed to the Protocol. Greece is the only participating country to have made rectifications of a purely formal character to its schedule of concessions in accordance with an ad hoc procedure devised to this effect.

8. A consolidated trilingual document on procedures for certification of origin has been prepared by the secretariat at the Committee's request. As provided in Annex A to the Protocol, the participating countries have undertaken a review of the rules of origin utilized by member countries in their trading relationships under the Protocol. No problems have been reported by participating countries in this respect.

9. At the request of the Participating countries, the International Trade Centre is undertaking a survey of markets in the participating countries in respect of products subject to tariff concessions. The Committee of Participating Countries gratefully acknowledges the contributions made by the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany and the Norwegian Agency for International Development (NORAD) which are financing this project.

D. Enlargement of the Protocol

10. Special sessions of the Committee of Participating Countries were held in November 1973 and June 1974, to which all developing countries were invited, to explore the possibilities for the further expansion of trade among developing countries. The Committee has suggested that in considering accession, interested developing countries might make use of procedures drawn up for this purpose in the light of discussions in the Committee of Participating Countries. The initial phase of such procedures includes the exploration of possibilities for seeking concessions on products of trade interest in the markets of participating countries as well as the relevance to the trade of non-participating countries of existing concessions contained in an Annex to the Protocol. It has been suggested, inter alia, that countries deciding to make use of the procedures for accession to the Protocol might indicate any particular problems they may have in relation to the Protocol so that possible approaches to such questions could be considered. A number of non-participating developing countries have requested the secretariat's assistance in examining questions related to accession including the initial identification and exploration process.

11. The Committee of Participating Countries has given consideration to the prospects for initiating a new round of trade negotiations among interested developing countries with a view to enlarging the scope of the concessions contained in the Protocol, extending the list of concessions and encouraging the accession of additional developing countries and decided to keep this matter under review. In this connexion the necessary preparatory work is being undertaken.

II. STATISTICAL DATA

12. Because of the relatively short time period since the Protocol entered into force and the time needed for the completion of ratification procedures and for the implementation of administrative procedures, rules of origin, etc. it has not been possible to assess the impact of the concessions on trade between member countries during the initial period of operations. However, in an effort to provide an indication of trade flows in respect of items covered by the Protocol, participating countries have collated relevant details of imports from other participating countries and imports from all sources in 1972 and 1973. These details are contained in section III of this report.¹
