UNITED STATES - TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS
OF CERTAIN LIVESTOCK ITEMS FROM CANADA

Addendum

The following communication, dated 21 January 1976, has been received from the United States Mission.

On 1 January 1976 the Government of the United States of America removed temporary quotas on the importations of beef from Canada. This action, contained in Proclamation No. 4110 issued 1 January 1976 is in response to the lifting by Canada of restrictions on meat imports from the United States. Temporary restrictions were placed by the United States on the importation of certain livestock items from Canada in November 1974 following Canadian restrictions on the importation of cattle, beef and veal from the United States. These restrictions were imposed by Proclamation No. 4335 on 16 November 1974 and the Contracting Parties were notified of them on 21 November 1974 (L/4118 of 25 November 1974). Proclamation No. 4110 terminates Proclamation No. 4335. Proclamation No. 4382 of 5 August 1975 terminated those parts of Proclamation No. 4335 pertaining to the importation of cattle, swine and pork from Canada.
