RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM ROMANIA

Addendum

- Eighteen notifications of restrictions on imports from Romania were circulated in document L/4170, dated 14 April 1975.
- Further notifications were circulated in documents L/4170/Add.1 and L/4170/Add.2. dated respectively 23 April and 3 June 1975.
- The following notifications have been received from Poland, Spain and Switzerland. 3.
- Contracting parties which have not yet submitted notifications are invited to do so without delay.

POLAND

Poland does not apply any restrictions to imports from Romania.

SPAIN

Spain does not maintain any discriminatory restrictions on imports from Romania.

SWITZERLAND

The situation with respect to Swiss imports from Romania is as follows:

1. Industrial products

Taking into account the arrangements made to facilitate mutual trade, imports into Switzerland of industrial products (finished, semi-finished and basic products) from Romania are not subject to any quantitative restrictions.

2. Agricultural products

Imports of agricultural products from Romania are subject to the same régime as imports from all other countries.

The special regulation in respect of eggs in the shell, which was applicable during the first half of the year and was tantamount to a global quota, has been suspended on a trial basis since I January 1975. This means that imports of eggs are unrestricted throughout the year.
