RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM POLAND

Notifications by Contracting Parties -

- In airgram GATT/AIR/1187 of 17 June 1975, contracting parties were invited to notify by 15 August 1975, for the purpose of item (i)(c) of the plan for the annual review of Poland's trade with contracting parties1, action taken under paragraph 3 of the Protocol for the Accession of Poland2 to remove remaining quantitative restrictions on imports from Poland.
- The Council, at its meeting on 28 April 1970, approved guidelines for the form and content of the notifications. These guidelines were reproduced in GATT/AIR/1187.

These notifications are reproduced hereunder.

Contracting parties which have not yet submitted notifications are invited to do so without delay.3 In this context it will be recalled that at the sirth annual review in October 1973 (BISD, Twentieth Supplement, paragraph 11, pages 2.1-212) the Working Party agreed to recommend that notifications should be made available at least six weeks before the consultations. This recommendation was reiterated by the Working Party at the seventh review in October 1974 (BISD, Twenty-first Supplement, paragraph 11, page 115). The eighth annual review is expected to commence on 9 October 1975.

<u>AUSTRIA</u>

Austria has removed, as from 1 January 1975, all discriminatory quantitative import restrictions applicable under paragraph 3 of the Protocol for the Accession of Poland on goods originating in Poland.

BPAZIL

Brazil does not apply any discriminatory prohibitions or quantitative restrictions on imports from Poland.

CANADA

As notified in previous years Canada does not maintain any discriminatory restrictions on imports from Poland.

CUBA

The Cuban Republic does not apply discriminatory restrictions of any kind in its trade with Poland.

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

The first part of this notification (List A) comprises a list of tariff headings included in the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No. 1439/74 (Community liberalization vis-à-vis third countries) and which are not yet covered by the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No. 109/70 (Community liberalization vis-à-vis State-trading countries).

This list comprises 115 full tariff headings and ninety-four partial tariff headings. It should be noted that imports from Poland of certain products in this list are liberalized in one or more member States. The number of economic zones of the Community that still maintain quantitative restrictions is indicated in parentheses beside each heading number. At the end of this list are the heading numbers concerning specifically the United Kingdom and Ireland (temporary exceptions under Annex VII of the Treaty of Accession).

The second part of the notification (List B) reports progress since the seventh annual review in eliminating quantitative restrictions. This list includes nine full tariff headings and twenty-nine partial tariff headings.

List C indicates, for information, the quantitative restrictions still applying for ECSC products.

It should be noted, lastly, that as in the past the Community has not intensified the discriminatory element of the restrictions but on the contrary has relaxed it progressively.

In addition, the autonomous import régimes in regard to State-trading countries as adopted by the Council on 27 March 1975 afford a substantial increase in import possibilities in relation to the quotas opened in 1974.

It should be noted that because of technical difficulties the statistical data concern only the six-member Community.

NORWAY

There has been no change in the Norwegian restrictions on imports from Poland in the period 30 June 1967 - 1 January 1975.

SOUTH AFRICA

South Africa does not now, and did not on 30 June 1967 apply any discriminatory import restrictions to imports from Poland.

SWEDEN

According to item (i) (c) of Annex A to the Protocol of Accession of the Polish People's Republic the Swedish Government notifies that, with effect from 1 January 1975, a partly new régime was introduced for certain goods from the Polish People's Republic. Thus, the products listed in Annex I were then removed from the list of goods subject to import licensing. By these and earlier unilateral liberalization measures only 63 BTN-items (plus 34 partly) are still subject to licensing.

For certain important and exceptional reasons the Swedish Government finds it necessary that the products listed in <u>Annex II</u> should still be subject to the import licensing procedure. Swedish production in the sectors concerned is sensitive to market disturbances and at the same time of importance for social, economic or emergency planning reasons.

The Swedish Government has declared that for items remaining on the list of goods referred to in Annex II:A, imports, as from 1 January 1975, will under normal market conditions be allowed without quantitative restrictions. The import licensing procedure for these products will serve as an instrument to keep imports under close surveillance.

The remaining few products still subject to quantitative restrictions and licensing are listed in Annex II:B, where the relevant quotas for 1974 and 1975 as well as the corresponding import values for 1974 are mentioned.

SWEDEN
