SCHEDULE V - CANADA

Invocation of Paragraph 5 of Article XXVIII

The following communication dated 23 December 1975 has been received from the Permanent Mission of Canada.

Pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 5 of Article XXVIII, I have the honour to ask you to notify the CONTRACTING PARTIES that Canada reserves its right, during the three-year period beginning on 1 January 1976, to modify Schedule V - Canada, to the extent required to permit certain commitments now expressed therein to be replaced by new commitments relating to the same commodities. The commitments which may be modified pursuant to this notification relate to photographic equipment, pleasure craft, glass fibres and filaments, fresh and processed fruits and vegetables, yeast, and vegetable oil products. These commodities were or are the subject of studies by the Canadian Tariff Board. The Board's report on photographic equipment has been received by the Canadian Government; the other reports will be submitted in due course.
