Schedule I - Australia

1. The Permanent Mission of Australia has transmitted to the secretariat on 14 September 1981 the enclosed list of modifications¹ to Schedule I - Australia as annexed to the Protocol Supplementary to the Geneva (1979) Protocol.
2. If no objection is notified to the secretariat within three months from the date of this document, the modifications will be deemed to be approved and their incorporation into Schedule I - Australia will be formally certified in connexion with the publication of the Australian schedule in loose-leaf form.

CERTIFICATION OF CHANGES TO SCHEDULE I - GOVERNMENT OF AUSTRALIA

The Australian Permanent Mission to the Office of the United Nations presents its compliments to the Director-General to the Contracting Parties to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade and has the honour to refer to the tariff concessions offered by Australia as a contribution to the Tokyo Round of the Multilateral Trade Negotiations and which were annexed to the Protocol Supplementary to the Geneva (1979) Protocol on 31 March 1980 as Schedule I - Government of Australia.

On instructions from its Government the Mission wishes to certify the inclusion of a further twelve items in that Schedule. The items are as follows:
