ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Modification of the Bilateral Agreement between the United States and Korea

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the United States a notification of a further modification of their bilateral agreement with Korea, concluded under Article 4 of the MFA. In this modification all limits established in 1983 were converted into specific limits.²

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding bilateral agreements notified under Article 4², has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

NEW SPECIFIC LIMITS ESTABLISHED IN US-KOREAN
 BILATERAL AGREEMENT

The specific limits listed below were established pursuant to paragraph 6(F) of the US-Korean bilateral agreement for the 1984-87 agreement years. The three wool categories (435, 442 and 448) have growth rates at 1 per cent and swing at 5 per cent. All other categories have growth rates at 2.5 per cent and swing at 7 per cent.
