#### AUSTRIA LETTER

Dear Mrs. Oranuj,

1. With reference to the textile agreement between Thailand and Austria as concluded on April 29, 1982, I wish to propose that the agreement be extended from July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985 and be automatically renewed for a further twelve-month term unless its termination is agreed upon after consultation between both parties.

2. Paragraph 3 of the present agreement be modified to cover only the exports, from Thailand to Austria, of woven blouses of man-made fibres or of cotton, CCCN No.ex 61.02.

3. As regards shirts of man made fibres or of cotton, CCCN No. ex 61.03, Austria and Thailand agree to consult immediately in case of need.

4. Other terms and condition of the present agreement shall remain.

If the above proposals are acceptable to your government this letter and your letter of confirmation shall constitute an agreement to the above effect.
