With reference to your letter TS/140-1, dated 21st February 1984, I have the honour to inform you the following:


- Macao does not apply any restrictions, being the market access completely free.

Macao applies "voluntary restraint" on its textiles exports for six countries in the terms of bilateral agreements signed under MFAs Article 4.
