ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Modification of the Bilateral Agreement between the EEC and Romania

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the Commission of the European Communities a notification concerning a further modification of the bilateral agreement between the EEC and Romania, concluded under Article 4 of the MFA, introducing restraints on imports of knitted tracksuits (Category 73) into the Community.

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding bilateral agreements notified under Article 4^2 , has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

AGREED MINUTE

- 1. Delegations of the Socialist Republic of Romania and the European Economic Community met at Brussels on 29 and 30 November 1983 for consultations in connection with the implementation of the bilateral EEC/Romania agreement on trade in textile products, initialled on 23 July 1982.
- 2. On the occasion of these consultations Romania agreed to limit its exports of track 'suits (Category 73 Nimexe Code 61.05-16; 17; 19) to the Community from 1 January 1983 to 31 December 1986 to the following annual levels:

On an exceptional basis, and for Italy only, the two parties agreed on an additional quantity of 15,000 pieces for the year 1983.

P.m.: The agreed EEC ceiling mentioned above does not take into account an additional quantity agreed on for France on 18 November 1983. This quantity is therefore additional to that mentioned above.

^{3.} It is agreed between the two parties that the provisions of the agreement concerning the export of products subject to quantitative limitations, and in particular the licensing procedures established under Protocol A to the agreement, shall apply to exports of the products mentioned above from 30 November 1983 onwards. From that date, the Romanian authorities shall issue export licences and certificates of origin up to the level of the limitations agreed on for exports to Italy, the United Kingdom, Denmark, Ireland and Greece. They will continue to issue export licences and certificates of origin up to the levels of the limitations agreed on under the agreement for exports to Germany, France and Benelux of the products concerned, including the additional quantities agreed on for France on 18 November 1983.
