#### Addendum

With reference to document COM.TD/W/409, the delegation of Japan has provided the following information on trade liberalization measures taken on 1 April 1985 with respect to certain tropical products.

Having regard to the consultations held on tropical products in accordance with the relevant Ministerial Decision in 1982 and the consultations held with certain least-developed countries since 1983, Japan has put into force the following tariff actions.

## CCCN 5710: Woven fabrics of jute or of other textile bast fibres

It may be recalled that with effect from 1 April 1984 Japan had extended to this item a special duty-free treatment for least-developed countries while maintaining ceiling limitations for this treatment (cf. Spec(84)27/Rev.l - jute and hard fibres).

With effect from 1 April 1985 two tariff actions have been taken on this item. First, ceiling limitations on duty-free treatment for least-developed countries have been eliminated. Thus, least-developed countries, including notably Bangladesh, now enjoy an unlimited duty-free treatment in the Japanese market. Secondly, GSP rate on this item has been reduced from 8 per cent to zero. Thus, GSP beneficiary countries are in a position to enjoy GSP duty-free treatment on this item although ceiling limitations remain for this treatment.

# Advance implementation of Tokyo Round concessions on a number of tropical products

By way of an advance implementation of Tokyo Round tariff concessions by two years, Japan has fully implemented its concessions on the following tropical products with effect from 1 April 1985.
