Note by the Secretariat

The secretariat has been asked to bring the attached communication to the attention of your delegation, as required by the first sentence in paragraph 4 of the agreed procedures for the surveillance mechanism (MTN.TNC/2).

Communication from Uruguay

We will appreciate your courtesy in bringing to the notice of the participants in the Uruguay Round the measures appearing in the enclosure to this note in regard to which we believe grounds exist making them relevant to rollback.

United States

It is our expectation that the consultations to be carried out with the United States, in accordance with agreed procedures, will be successfully concluded in time for appropriate information to be supplied to the Surveillance Body by 31 December 1987.
