ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4

Modification of the bilateral agreement between the United States and Malaysia

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from the United States of a further modification of its bilateral agreement with Malaysia, under which a restraint was agreed on wool skirts (Category 442). $^{\rm 1}$

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications made under Article 4, has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

UNITED STATES AND MALAYSIA AMENDS BILATERAL TEXTILE AGREEMENT

The United States and Malaysia amend their bilateral textile agreement. Texts of the notes tollow:

UNITED STATES NOTE

December 11, 1986

The Secretary of State presents his compliments to His Excellency the Ambassador of Malaysia and has the honor to refer to the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles, done at Geneva on December 20, 1973, and extended by Protocol adopted on July 31, 1986 and to the Agreement concerning trade in textiles and apparel between the United States and Malaysia effected by exchange of notes on July 1 and 11, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the Agreement). The Government of the United States also refers to consultations held in Washington, D.C. on December 3, 1986. As a result of these consultations the Government of the United States has the honor to propose the following amendments to the Agreement:

(I) Annex B of the Agreement shall be amended to include:

Swing, carryover and carryforward shall be available pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the Agreement.

(II) For Category 605-T, special carryforward of 20,000 pounds shall be available for September 1 - December 31, 1986.

If these proposals are acceptable to the Government of Malaysia, this note and the Embassy of Malaysia's note of reply shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement.
