## ARRANGEMENT RECARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4

Modification of the bilateral agreement between the EEC and Indonesia

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from the EEC of a modification of its bilateral agreement with Indonesia. A restraint was agreed at the Community level on cotton fabrics (Category 2).

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications made under Article 4, has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

## AGREED MINUTE

- A delegation of the Republic of Indonesia and a delegation of the European Communities met in Jakarta on 10 - 12 September 1987 for consultations under Article 8 of the bilateral Agreement on trade in textiles initialled on 28 June 1986.
- 2. As a result of these consultations Indonesia agreed to limit its exports of products falling under category 2 to the Community as follows:

5. It was understood by both sides that the flexibility provisions of the Agreement which concern exports of products subject to quantitative limits established in Annex II of the Agreement shall apply to the quantitative limits referred to in paragraphs 2 and 3.
