TURKEY - SCHEDULE OF CONCESSIONS

The following communication, dated 28 December 1987, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Turkey.

I have the pleasure to notify you, for the information of the countries parties to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries, that my Government has decided, following the request made by the Permanent Mission of Bangladesh on 10 December 1986, to grant unilaterally certain tariff concessions on imports of products, such as jute fibres, yarn of jute, woven fabrics of jute and jute sacks, in the framework of the above-mentioned Protocol.

I would therefore request you to include in Turkey's Schedule of Concessions annexed to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations among Developing Countries the attached list of these new products with the concessions granted, which came into force on 27 December 1987 after publication in the Turkish Official Gazette of that date.
