ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Extension of the bilateral agreement
between Sweden and Korea

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from Sweden of an extension of its bilateral agreement with Korea for the period 1 March to 30 June 1987. This¹ extension replaces the provisional extension notified earlier to the TSB.

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications made under Article 4,² has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for information.

Memorandum of Understanding

The Agreement between, the Republic of Korea and Sweden concerning exports of certain textile products from the Republic of Korea to Sweden, entered into on December 5, 1983/January 13, 1984, is hereby extended for the period March 1 - June 30, 1987. The items under restraint and the levels to be applied during the period of extension are given in Annex I to this Memorandum.

In accordance with Article 5 of the aforementioned Agreement, the Korean side will issue Export Certificates up to the levels in Annex I to this Memorandum. The relevant period, i.e., March 1 - June 30, 1987 shall appear on every Export Certificate issued during the period of extension. All the other relevant provisions of the Agreement of December 5, 1983/January 13, 1984 shall also apply during the period of extension.
