**Addendum**

**Status of restrictions maintained by participating countries**

The attached tables contain details of restrictions maintained by participating countries and reviewed by the Textiles Surveillance Body during the period 1 October 1987 to 23 September 1988. The tables include:

- (a) Restrictions notified under Article 2, paragraphs 1 or 4;
- (b) Measures notified under Article 3, paragraphs 5 and/or 8;
- (c) Bilateral agreements or amendments of agreements notified under Article 4;
- (d) Measures or agreements notified under Articles 7 and/or 8;
- (e) Other restrictions notified under Article 11.

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<sup>1</sup> As indicated in the tables, certain agreements concluded by Canada and the United States included products made of fibres specified in paragraph 24 of the 1986 Protocol. However, the following products were specifically excluded in those agreements:

Canada - Products containing more than 85 per cent by weight of vegetable fibres, other than cotton, or more than 70 per cent by weight of silk fibres;

United States - Garments which contain 70 per cent or more silk by weight in a silk blend (unless they also contain 17 per cent or more by weight of wool), and products other than garments which contain 85 per cent or more silk by weight.
