ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4

Amendment of the bilateral agreement
between the EEC and Korea

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from the EEC of an amendment of its bilateral agreement with Korea. A restraint was agreed for the period 1 January 1988 to 31 December 1991, on impregnated textile fabrics (Category 100) when imported into Spain.¹

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications made under Article 4,² has examined the relevant documentation, and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

AGREED MINUTE

A delegation of the Republic of Korea and a delegation of the European Economic Community met in Brussels on 18 October 1988 for consultations under Article 9 of the bilateral Agreement on trade in textiles initialled on 7 August 1986.

A a result of these consultations the Republic of Korea agreed to limit its exports of products falling under Category 100 to the Community's region of Spain as follows :

It was understood by both sides that the provisions of the Agreement which concern exports of products subject to quantitative limits established in Annex II of the Agreement shall apply to the exports referred to above.
