ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4

Modification of a Bilateral Agreement between Norway and Yugoslavia

The Textiles Surveillance Body received a notification from Norway of a modification of its bilateral agreement with Yugoslavia. The restraint level for Category 7 (bedlinen) was increased.¹

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications made under Article 4,² has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

1. Delegations from the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Kingdom of Norway met in Belgrade on 13 - 14 October 1988 for consultations in accordance with Paragraph 15 of the Agreement relating to the exports from the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia of certain textile products for imports into Norway, signed in Belgrade on 18 January 1988.

2. As a result of these consultations it was agreed to initial the enclosed amendment to the Textile Agreement

Amendment

to the Agreement relating to the exports from the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia of certain textile products for imports into Norway, signed in Belgrade on 18 January 1988

During consultations held in Belgrade on 13 - 14 October 1988 in accordance with Paragraph 15 of the Agreement, Norway and the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia agreed to the following amendment:

In annex B the restraint level for cat. No. 7 under (b) to be increased from 20.000 kgs to 30.000 kgs.
