ISRAEL - SCHEDULE OF CONCESSIONS

The following communication, dated 11 July 1989, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Israel.

I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Israel has decided to add the products mentioned in the attached list to Israel's schedule of concessions annexed to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries. All products included in this list have become duty-free as of 1 July 1989 upon importation from Developing Countries signatories of the above-mentioned Protocol.

It should be stressed that these are autonomous tariff concessions and the Government of Israel reserves the right to modify or to withdraw these concessions or part of them at any time.

Having regard to the on-going exercise of expansion of trade among developing countries, the Government of Israel offers these concessions as an invitation to Developing Countries to negotiate further tariff reductions under the Protocol, thus contributing to its strengthening and aiming at achieving greater trade liberalization among developing countries.

It is requested that this communication and the attached list will be circulated to signatories of the Protocol and be included in Israel's schedule of concessions, in accordance with the normal procedures.

As agreed by the Committee at the meeting held on 11 July 1989, if no objections to the inclusion of additional items in the Schedule of Concessions of Israel are notified to the secretariat within sixty days from the date of this document, the additional items listed in the attachment will be included in a certification of changes to schedules reproducing the ? dated schedule of Israel.
