Report on the Status of Restrictions Maintained by Participating Countries

In accordance with the requirements of Article 11, the TSB requested the Chairman in February 1989 to invite all participating countries to submit information under Article 11, paragraphs 11, 12 and 2 on the status of restrictions maintained by them on imports from all sources of textile products covered by the Arrangement.
