ACCESSION OF BANGLADESH

The following communication dated 27 November 1989 has been received from the representative of Bangladesh requesting an extension of the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh.

I have the honour to refer to the Protocol for the Accession of Bangladesh to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries, dated 20 August 1976, and to request an indefinite extension of the duration of the said Protocol of Accession.

The secretariat has drawn up a draft decision extending the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh. This draft is annexed hereto for consideration at the meeting of the Committee of Participating Countries to be held on 6 December 1989.

ANNEX

Extension of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh

Draft Decision

Considering the request of the Government of Bangladesh for an indefinite extension of the duration of its Protocol of Accession to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries.

The COMMITTEE OF PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES,

Decides in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 14 of the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries to extend the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh indefinitely.
