In the light of a request by the representative of Bangladesh (CPC/105) for and extension of the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries, the Committee of Participating Countries <u>edopted</u> the following Decision:

Extension of Duration

Decision of 6 December 1989

<u>Considering</u> the request of the Government of Bangladesh for an indefinite extension of the duration of its Protocol of Accession to the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries;

The COMMITTEE OF PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

<u>Decides</u> in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 14 of the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries to extend the duration of the Protocol of Accession of Bangladesh until 31 December 1999.
