Description of content: The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is issuing a tentative final rule that sets forth amendments to its food labelling regulations that define, and provide for the proper use of, the terms "cholesterol free", "low cholesterol", and "reduced cholesterol" in the labelling of foods and that provide for the use of other truthful and non-misleading statements about cholesterol content on food labelling. This tentative final rule will permit meaningful declarations about the cholesterol content of foods while preventing misleading claims about this food component. The agency is soliciting comments on the levels of fat and saturated fatty acids in food that, if exceeded, would make the use of the terms "cholesterol free" or "low cholesterol" in food labelling misleading. The tentative final rule also sets forth amendments to the agency's regulations regarding the label declaration of the cholesterol and fatty acid content of foods and sets forth related agency policies.
