Sir,

Pursuant to your request dated 30 April 1990 and to Article 11, in particular paragraphs 2, 11 and 12, of the Multifibre Arrangement, I have the honour to communicate the following:

Switzerland has not instituted and does not apply any quantitative restrictions, bilateral agreements or other quantitative measures having a restrictive effect on textiles products covered by the Arrangement. Automatic licences, however, are required for certain products in conformity with the Federal Council Ordinance of 30 November 1987 and the Federal Department of Public Economy Ordinance of 2 December 1987, of which we transmitted copies to you on 16 June 1988, and which have not been amended since that date.
