| 5. Title: Technical Regulations and Methods of Measurement for VHF and UHF Mobile Radio Telephony (MB 04-1)   |
| 6. Description of content: The draft regulation lays down technical rules and associated methods of measurement with which equipment must comply in order to be placed on the market and used.  |
| 7. Objective and rationale: In view of technical developments, it has been necessary to extend the frequency bands from 500 mhz. to 1,000 mhz. To permit trunking in the 410 to 430 mhz. frequency band, the intermodulation suppression limits have been adjusted to bring them more closely into line with other European regulations. The frequency tolerance has been tightened, as laid down in the ITU radio regulations. |
