5.	Title: Draft Decision of the Committee of Ministers of the Benelux Economic Union Concerning Maximum Content of Certain Heavy Metals in Foodstuffs
6.	Description of content: The countries of the Benelux Economic Union intend to harmonize and fix jointly maximum authorized contents of cadmium, lead and mercury, expressed in mg./kg., in a number of basic foodstuffs.
7.	Objective and rationale: Pending a Community regulation in this area, the Benelux countries wish, in order to protect consumer health, to set maximum authorized contents for the most dangerous heavy metals from the toxicological standpoint which may be present in ordinary foodstuffs. In the Netherlands, authorized maximum contents have already been fixed by law. These levels have to be adapted to free movement within the Benelux area.
