4. Products covered (HS or CCCN where applicable, otherwise national tariff heading): Motor vehicles (HS Chapter 87)
5. Title: Fuel System Integrity; Alcohol Fuels (5 pages)
6. Description of content: The Administration is responsible for establishing motor vehicle safety standards for new vehicles and equipment to reduce motor vehicle accidents, deaths and injuries. In this regard, the Administration wishes to have any necessary safety standards in place, that would support the safe introduction and operation of alternative fuel vehicles, and not impede the development and advancement of such vehicles and the associated technology. The purpose of this notice is to solicit comments to help the Administration determine whether Standard 301, Fuel System Integrity, should be amended to set specialized requirements for vehicles using methanol or ethanol as a motor fuel.
7. Objective and rationale: To help achieve a cleaner and more healthy environment by using alternative fuels.
