The Committee of Participating Countries provided for in the Protocol Relating to Trade Negotiations Among Developing Countries will hold its sixtieth meeting on Wednesday 12 December 1990, at 11 a.m. in the Centre William Rappard, 154 rue de Lausanne, Geneva. The meeting will also be open to delegations of countries having signed but not yet ratified the Protocol.

The following items have been proposed for inclusion in the agenda for the meeting:

1. Expansion of trade among developing countries (paragraph 7 of the Summary of Discussions (CPC/111) of the last meeting). At the last meeting, the Committee agreed to examine at its next meeting the question of the expansion of trade among developing countries and to consider the proposal concerning the advanced implementation of concessions among participating countries. Members may wish to review developments and exchange views on matters relevant to this agenda item.
