PROTOCOL REGARDING CERTAIN MILK POWDERS

Communication from the Permanent Representative of the Republic of Poland

The following communication, dated 10 December 1990, has been received from the Permanent Representative of the Republic of Poland.

Pursuant to Article 3:5 of the Protocol Regarding Certain Milk Powders, we wish to notify that we intend to conclude sales of a total of 4,177 metric tons of skimmed milk powder (SMP) for animal feed as specified below:
