In accordance with your request of 23 December 1991 and pursuant to Article 11, in particular paragraphs 2, 11 and 12, of the Multi-fibre Arrangement, I have the honour to inform you of the following:

Switzerland has not introduced and does not maintain any quantitative restrictions, bilateral agreements or other quantitative measures having a restrictive effect on the textiles products covered by the arrangement. Automatic licensing, however, is required for certain products in accordance with the Federal Council Order of 30 November 1987 and the Federal Department of the Public Economy Order of 2 December 1987, as amended on 25 March 1992, with entry into force on 1 April 1992. The decision of the Federal Council introducing these amendments is attached hereto.

Amendment of 25 March 1992

The Federal Department of the Public Economy Decides:

I

The DFEP Order of 2 December 1987^{1} on textile imports is amended as follows:

Article 2, paragraph 4

Textiles imported on a preferential basis under free-trade agreements may be imported without authorization.
