With reference to the information requested by the Textiles Surveillance Body under Article 11 of the Multi-fibre Arrangement, I have pleasure in informing you that the changes in the restrictions applied by Mexico in respect of trade in textile products, since the last notification sent to the TSB (reference OF/GATT/206/89 of 4 August 1989), have resulted in the elimination of almost all quantitative restrictions on imports. Currently only the tariff heading 6309 0001 (used clothing) is subject to prior import licensing.
