Description of content: The purpose of the amendment to the Motor Vehicle Safety Regulations, section 216, entitled "Roof Intrusion Protection", is to reduce the risk of fatalities and injuries during rollovers of vehicles on Canadian highways by requiring the roofs of light trucks and vans to meet a required strength. This amendment will require that new trucks, multipurpose passenger vehicles and buses having a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of less than 2,728 kg. comply with the requirement now applicable to passenger cars, which specifies that their roofs resist a crushing force equal to 1.5 times the GVWR of the vehicle. 7.
