6.000	Description of content: This document proposes to amend Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 125, Warning Devices. That standard specifies requirements for non-powered warning devices designed to be carried in all types of motor vehicles and set out on the roadway to warn oncoming traffic of a stopped vehicle in or near the roadway. As amended, the standards would apply only to warning devices that are designed to be carried in buses and trucks that have a gross vehicle weight rating greater than 10,000 pounds (4,536 kilogrammes).
