Following our recent accession to the MFA and in accordance with Article 2:1 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Textiles (MFA), the Government of Honduras informs the Textiles Surveillance Body that it does not apply any quantitative restrictions to imports of textiles or clothing.

In this context, we reaffirm our intention not to introduce quantitative restrictions on imports of these products since such action would be inconsistent with the provisions in the GATT and the MFA.
