SENEGAL - RENEGOTIATION OF A SCHEDULE XLIX

Extension of Time-Limit

Decision of 19 July 1993¹

Considering that the CONTRACTING PARTIES, by their Decision of 7 December 1990², suspended the application of the provisions of Article II of the General Agreement to the extent necessary to enable the Government of Senegal to implement its new tariff resulting from a thorough re-organization and the introduction of the Harmonized System, and thereafter to conduct negotiations;

Considering that the CONTRACTING PARTIES, by successive Decisions, extended until 30 June 1993 the time-limit established for the completion of the negotiations or consultations to be conducted by the Government of Senegal;

 $\underline{\text{Noting}}$ that the new schedule and the accompanying documentation will be circulated shortly;

Considering that the Government of Senegal has requested a further extension until 31 December 1993 in order to conduct the negotiations and consultations provided for by the procedures under Article XXVIII of the General Agreement with interested contracting parties;

The CONTRACTING PARTIES, acting pursuant to the provisions of Article XXV:5 of the General Agreement,

<u>Decide</u>, in view of the exceptional circumstances, to extend the time-limit provided for in the Decision of 7 December 1990 until 31 December 1993.

The Decision was adopted by postal ballot. There were 70 votes in favour and none against.
