Description of content: On the basis of the Convention of the Protection of the Marine Environment of the Baltic Sea Area use and import of twenty-nine fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, slimicides and chemicals used for preservation of wood, timber, wood pulp, cellulose, paper, hides and textiles are forbidden. The chemicals listed in the Appendix of Decision are acrylonitrile, aldrin, aramite, cadmium-compounds, chlordane, chlordecone, chlordimeform, chloroform, 1.2-dibromethane, dieldrin, DDT (1.1.1-trichloro-2.2-bis (chlorophenyl) -ethane) and its derivatives DDE and DDD, endrin, fluoroacetic acid and derivatives, heptachlor, isobenzane, isodrin, kelevan, lead-compounds, mercury-compounds, morfamquat, nitrophen, pentachlorophenol, polychlorinated terpenes, quintozene, selenium-compounds, 2.4.5-T and toxaphene.
