6.	Description of content: Ban on certain use of HCFCs. Ban on import of certain products forming part of or containing plastic foam which has been manufactured using HCFCs as the blowing agent. Ban on the import of halons.
7.	Objective and rationale: Environmental protection. HCFCs as well as halons deplete the ozone layer, which protects against UV radiation. The proposed Ordinance aims at achieving further reduction of the use of HCFCs and halons. The ban on halons is an implementation of an agreement among the parties to the Montreal Protocol. The same applies to the HCFC Regulations although the Swedish reduction will be faster.
