UNITED STATES CARIBBEAN BASIN ECONOMIC RECOVERY ACT

**Report of the Government of the United States
on the Trade-Related Provisions of the
Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act of 1983
for the Years 1990, 1991 and 1992**

Introduction

On February 15, 1985, the Contracting Parties to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT) decided, *inter alia*, to waive until September 30, 1995, the provisions of paragraph 1 of Article 1 of the General Agreement, "to the extent necessary to permit the Government of the United States to provide duty-free treatment to the eligible imports of Caribbean Basin countries benefitting from the provisions of the [Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery] Act, without being required to extend the same duty-free treatment to like products of any other contracting party." In accordance with paragraph 7 of that Decision, the United States is providing its report to the GATT Contracting Parties on the U.S. Government's implementation of the trade-related provisions of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act of 1983 (CBERA), more commonly known as the Caribbean Basin Initiative (CBI). This report covers events from October 1990 and data for calendar years 1990-1992.

Duty-free Treatment under the CBERA

Title II, section 211 of the CBERA allows the President of the United States to eliminate duties on all products, with certain exceptions¹, from those Caribbean countries that he designates as beneficiary countries. Presently, there are 24 countries which are eligible to receive the benefits of the duty-free provisions of the CBERA. The most recent designation, for Nicaragua, was effective November 13, 1990. The following 20 countries were designated on January 1, 1984: Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Belize, British Virgin Islands, Costa Rica, Dominica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Grenada, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Montserrat, Netherlands Antilles, Panama, St. Christopher-Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, and Trinidad and Tobago. The Bahamas was designated a CBERA beneficiary country on March 14, 1985. On April 11, 1986, Aruba was designated a CBERA beneficiary retroactive to January 1, 1986, upon becoming independent of the Netherlands Antilles. Guyana was designated a CBERA beneficiary effective on November 24, 1988.

Panama's beneficiary status under the CBERA was suspended on April 9, 1988, making it the first country to lose its designated status. Panama's benefits were restored effective March 17, 1990.

¹The products excluded from duty-free treatment are: textile and apparel articles which are subject to textile agreements; certain footwear which was not eligible for duty-free entry under the U.S. Generalized System of Preferences in 1983; prepared tuna in airtight containers; petroleum and petroleum products; watches and watch parts if such products contain any material from countries not accorded MFN treatment.

Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Expansion Act

On August 20, 1990, President Bush signed the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Expansion Act of 1990 (CBEREA). The principal change to the CBERA was to delete the termination date of September 30, 1995. The CBI is now a permanent program.

Other trade-related provisions enacted by the CBEREA include:

- a 20 per cent tariff reduction applied to certain leather products (handbags, luggage, flat goods, work gloves, and leather wearing apparel), which is being phased in over five years beginning in 1992 and will be limited to 2.5 per cent ad valorem; and
- duty-free imports from beneficiary countries for products made from 100 per cent U.S. components, except for textile articles, apparel articles, petroleum, and certain products derived from petroleum.

Annex 1 contains a list of the products eligible for the duty reductions (noted above), and United States imports of these products for 1990, 1991 and 1992. A total of 46 tariff categories are affected, with 1992 imports of \$59 million dollars.

In addition, as part of the ongoing efforts to make the program more effective through administrative enhancements, the list of products eligible for CBI duty-free treatment has been expanded through two proclamations. Effective September 28, 1991 (Presidential Proclamation Number 6343), new or expanded duty free treatment was provided for 94 tariff categories, affecting \$47 million dollars in 1991 imports. A second expansion was effective on July 17, 1992 (Presidential Proclamation Number 6455). A total of 28 tariff categories were provided new or expanded status as CBI-eligible goods. The total U.S. imports of these products was \$3.4 million in 1991 and \$4.6 million in 1992. A list of products affected by these expansions can be found in Annex 2.

CBI Performance

The tremendous expansion in nontraditional exports from CBI beneficiary countries since the inauguration of the CBI program has greatly cushioned the declines in traditional exports, primarily petroleum, from the region. On a region-wide basis, this export diversification has led to a more balanced production and export base and has resulted in a reduction in the region's vulnerability to fluctuations in markets for traditional products.

Total CBI country exports to the United States, excluding petroleum, increased by 103 per cent between 1983, the year prior to the implementation of the CBI, and 1992. However, the first few years of the CBI program coincided with plummeting petroleum prices. U.S. petroleum imports from the region's primary petroleum exporters, Aruba, Bahamas, Netherlands Antilles, and Trinidad and Tobago, fell dramatically, resulting in a significant drop in total CBI exports to the United States during 1983-85. Largely because of this decline, the region's total exports to the United States in 1988 were 30 per cent below their 1983 level. However, total CBI exports have since increased by 55 per cent, and were 7 per cent above 1983 levels in 1992.

Since 1988, however, significant nontraditional export growth was responsible for 85 per cent of the increase in the region's total exports to the United States. The region's nontraditional exports to the United States have expanded by over 14.11 per cent since 1983 and 17.5 per cent since 1988. In 1992, nontraditional exports constituted 66 per cent of the region's total exports to the United States, compared with only 22 per cent in 1983. These new exports include: apparel products, seafood,

footwear parts, jewelry, medical instruments, electronic apparatus, and fresh and processed fruits and vegetables.

Apparel and textile exports represented approximately 53 per cent of the region's nontraditional exports in 1992. While apparel products are excluded from the CBI's duty-free access to the United States, the Guaranteed Access Levels (GAL) program allows guaranteed quota access for countries negotiating such agreements with the United States for apparel products made from U.S. formed and cut fabric. Over three-fourths of the regions apparel exports are exported to the United States from CBI countries that have negotiated GAL agreements.

Statistical annexes are provided to present a detailed description of the trade aspects of the CBI program, focussing primarily on the period 1990-92. (GATT document L/6146, dated April 3, 1987, provides data for the years 1982-86; GATT document L/6773, dated December 11, 1990 covers 1987-89). Annex 3 includes a list of the beneficiaries ranked according to the value of U.S. imports entered under the CBERA provisions. Annex 4 contains a list of the leading products, ranked by value, entered under the CBERA duty-free provisions in 1989. Annex 5 contains a table showing the U.S. trade balance with each of the CBERA beneficiaries and for all beneficiaries as a whole. Annex 6 contains data showing U.S. imports of the top 35 products from each beneficiary and from all of the beneficiaries combined.

Annex 1:**Products and trade affected by staged duty reductions
on luggage, handbags, flat goods, work gloves,
and leather wearing apparel.**

Section 213(h)(1) of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act (CBERA) was amended by section 212 of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Expansion Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-382), directed the President to proclaim reductions in the rates of duty on handbags, luggage, flat goods, work gloves, and leather wearing apparel that are (1) the product of any beneficiary country, and (2) were not already designated as eligible for duty-free entry into the United States as of August 5, 1983 under the provisions of the U.S. Generalized System of Preferences (Title V of the Trade Act of 1974, 19 [U.S.C. 2461, et seq.]).

Table 1 shows the Harmonized Tariff System (HTS) categories affected by the proclamation, and the staging of the duty reductions. Table 2 shows 1990-1992 imports from current CBI beneficiaries of the affected products, while Table 3 shows imports for each tariff category.

Annex 2:

**October 1991 and June 1992 expansions of the
CBI-eligible product list**

As part of an effort to improve the operation of CBI program through administrative enhancement of the program, the President proclaimed on September 28, 1991 that new or more liberal duty-free treatment was being provided to 94 product categories. Twenty-four of the products were eligible for duty-free treatment under the U.S. Generalized System of Preferences (GSP), and were provided the same treatment under the CBI. The remaining 70 products were already eligible, in part, for CBI treatment. However, their eligibility was restricted by conditions related to content and country of origin. These restrictions were eliminated by the proclamation. An additional 28 products were added to the CBI by a Presidential Proclamation of July 17, 1992.

Attachment I lists the products affected by the October Proclamation. Table 1 provides trade data. Attachments II and Table 2 provide the same information for the July Proclamation.
