Printers processing exclusively paper sizes smaller than A4 are not required to fulfil the consumption target values.</p>						
5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Annex 11 to the Regulation Concerning an Economical and Rational Energy Use						
6.	<p>Description of content: To reduce the power consumption of printers, a target value (target values are not equal to standards. They indicate the power consumption in stand-by and off mode that should be reached by the end of 1996. Target values do not restrict the trade of appliances sold within Switzerland.)
