5.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Draft Mexican Official Standard NOM-011-SSA1-1993, Environmental Health. Permissible Limits of Soluble Lead and Cadmium in Glazed Earthenware Articles.
6.	Description of content: This Standard establishes the limiting amounts of soluble lead and cadmium in glazed earthenware articles intended to contain food or beverages. Applies to any type of glaze, whether or not coloured, with or without decoration, which may be on the inside, outside or both sides of the article. Applies to articles with glazing fired at temperatures below (990 °C). Glazing and/or decoration containing cadmium is subject to this Standard whatever the firing temperature.
