Description of content: The Commission seeks comments on a proposal to add general service fluorescent lamps, medium base compact fluorescent lamps and general service incandescent lamps to the list of products subject to provisions of the above referenced rule, commonly referred to as the Appliance Labelling Rule.

Objective and rationale: This action is being taken pursuant to the Energy Policy Act of 1992, which directed the Commission to prescribe, by 24 April 1994, rules requiring such products to be labelled with disclosures that will enable a purchaser to select the most energy efficient lamps that meet his or her requirements.
